CTREE

- Annual Economic Education Conference
- Usually late May or early June
 - CTREE 2024 will be May 29-31
- Location moves
 - Usually Eastern US Central US Western US
 - Atlanta 2024 Chicago 2022 Portland 2023
 - Often in a Federal Reserve city in alternating years
- Call for Submissions
 - Portal opens September 1
 - Deadline for submissions <u>December 1</u>



Types of Submissions

- Individual Paper
- Complete (Paper) Session
- Poster
- Panel
- Workshop
- Volunteer to serve as a
 - session chair, or
 - discussant



Submission Review & Notifications

- Submissions are reviewed and scored (4-point scale) by a 3-member CTREE program committee
- Scores are averaged and then submissions are sorted by average scores for each submission type
- A cut-off average score is identified
 - For the 2023 CTREE, cut-off was 3.0
- All submitters are notified in early February of the decision regarding their submission(s)
- Program is available and registration opens in mid-February
